TOPIC	DISCUSSION
Minutes	Minutes from the June 14, 2018 Public Safety Committee meeting were approved. Motion by Tr. Miller, seconded by Tr. Sittig
Lake County Sheriff Contract Update	<p>Mr. Nellessen let the committee know that as a result of the election there will be a new Sheriff. He assured the committee that there is no anticipation of any issue regarding the current contract.</p> <p>Mr. Kindseth updated the committee on public safety activities in the Village. Chair Sittig and Trustee Miller both articulated concerns about the lack of robust and timely communication from the Sheriff's Department on goings-on within the Village. Mr. Kindseth agreed that this is a topic to discuss with the next Sheriff.</p> <p>Mr. Kindseth briefed the committee on the successful liquor compliance checks that were conducted by the Sheriff in the last quarter.</p> <p>The next Beach Park meeting with the Sheriff's office is on December 12, 2018.</p>
Fire Department Communications Equipment on Green Bay Road	Mr. Nellessen provided a status of the microwave dishes being installed on Green Bay Road – work will begin next week. This has been an interregional effort that has been going very well. The work is anticipated to be completed in the next month.
Emergency Operations Plan Progress	Mr. Nellessen let the committee know that Lake County has reviewed the EOP and the Village has made updates per their recommendations. The plan will be resubmitted to Lake County next week. Once Lake County has approved it -- the plan will then go to the Village Board for adoption.
Recent Weather Activities	The committee reviewed and discussed the November 25, 2018 snow event. Administrator Kindseth briefed the group on snow operations and current utility status and resident assistance.

Mr. Kindseth provided an update on what the progress in Springfield. Action is anticipated to happen in the next 30 days.</p>
