Program Expectations

Adopt-A-Street sponsors provide a valuable service to the Village of Beach Park and we honor them for their commitment and dedication to keeping Beach Park streets clean and appealing for our residents and those who visit us.

Sponsors are asked to clean their adopted street right-of-way at least four times a year – once in the spring, once in the fall, and two other times as needed.

Items needed for cleaning are provided by the Village: trash bags for debris collection, safety vests, and gloves. It is suggested that a call to the Public Works Office, 847-746-1770, be made so staff can have things ready when you pick them up.

You are advised not to have unsupervised minors helping and to exercise extreme caution when working near traffic. Always wear your vest and gloves, and if you are concerned, you may request traffic signage to be placed out during your clean up.

Any items found on the right-of-way that are either too large for collection such as tires, or are beyond your abilities to collect or remove, such as a dead animal, should be reported to Public Work for removal. Full trash bags can be left on the street corners of the area cleaned, but should be reported to Public Works for collection.
