

RULES FOR BURNING

- No burning within 25 feet of any structure on the property.
- Burning permitted between dawn to dusk.
- Only landscape waste including branches and dried leaves are allowed to burn. No burning of paper, garbage or construction material is allowed.
- No fire shall be left unattended or left to grow so large as to pose a danger to the safety of any building, structure or nearby trees.
- A water source must be available.
- No fires shall be set when the winds are greater than 10 miles per hour.
- All fires must be supervised by an individual at least 18 years of age.
- No fire shall be set in any public right of ways (including ditches), public land or public places.
- No person shall burn any materials that have been brought from any other location.
- A burn permit is required from December 1 to March 31.
